Ranger's Nature Trail

Follow a 1 hour walk to the Old Hall and back again. It offers easy walking on level ground and is suitable for families with older children. There's an additional 30 minute loop around Melchett Mere. Nature Trail Booklet available from the Gift Shop for 50p.

Dairy Wood Way with the Billie the Beetle Trail

This short, circular woodland walk starts opposite the main car park, and is perfect for mini explorers to learn about Billie and her forest friends.

Beech Avenue Conservation Trail

This 1.5 mile trail runs alongside ancient beech trees planted in 1739.
